STEP BY STEP GUIDE FOR MAKING E-PAYMENT OF PROFESSIONS TAX THROUGH ODISHA TREASURY PORTAL

A simplified and online payment process for payment of Professional Tax has been provided for all taxpayers. The process allows the Taxpayer to pay using several modes like Net Banking, Debit Card, Credit Card, NEFT or RTGS etc. to pay the Professional Tax.


In addition to the above, facility has also been provided for taxpayers to pay Professional Tax using their GSTIN also.

In order to make the payment using these online facilities, the following information need to be readily available with the Taxpayer


- (i) TIN (11-digit registration / Enrolment Number) under Professional Tax; or
- (ii) GSTIN
- (iii) Jurisdictional Circle where the Taxpayer is registered under PT;
- (iv) Range under which the Circle (can be selected from the dropdown boxes)

The Step-by-Step process is elaborated below.


1. Please go to the website of CT & GST Organisation, Odisha at "https://odishatax.gov.in". The following page will open.




2. Click on "e-Payment" link as shown in the above picture. This will re-direct to a new tab for the Treasury Portal e-Payment page as can be seen from below.




3. Select the PROFESSIONAL TAX option by clicking on the radio button as shown above. It will open a screen asking to fill up dealer details as shown below.




4. Please enter the details of the Taxpayer making the payment of PT. In the screenshots below, dummy details have been filled up for use in this guide only. It may please be noted here that either the TIN or the GSTIN can be entered in the "Registration Type" box as shown below. The filled-up page is shown below.




- 5. As can be seen from the above screen, Challan is to be generated by providing dummy details for the month of October 2021 (in form of admitted tax on monthly basis). Please note that these details are to be filled up carefully and all mandatory fields are required to be filled up.
- 6. After filling up these details, please select the "Tax" unit and enter the amount, as can be seen from the screenshot above. Click on the "Next" to proceed to the next screen as shown below.




7. In the above screen, please enter the details of the Depositor (can be the same or different from the Taxpayer, if the deposit is being made by someone on behalf of the taxpayer or as the case may be). Click on the "Next" to proceed to next screen.




8. Please check the details for correctness and if all the information entered are correct, click on "Next" to proceed to the next screen. In case any changes are required, click on the "Previous" to go back to previous screens. Clicking on the "Next" will take to the payment options screen as can be seen from below.




- 9. It can be seen from above that there are several options / modes of payment made available to the Taxpayer to pay the Professional Tax. Those are shown below.
 - (a) **SBI e-Pay** the screenshot can be seen from the above picture.
 - (b) **Debit Cards** this facility is provided through different payment gateways like Axis Bank CC Avenue, ICICI Bank and Indian Bank BillDesk through which several debit cards can be used to pay the tax. The screenshot is shown below




(c) Net Banking – Taxpayers can pay using the Net Banking mode and many banks are included in this option. Also some payment gateways like Bill Desk and CC Avenue etc. are also included. The screenshot is given below.



(d) UPI and Wallet – Payment can be made using the UPI payment gateway of Axis Bank CC Avenue as can be seen from the screenshot below.



(e) Over the counter – Taxpayers can also make the payment using the over the counter mode through listed banks as can be seen from the screen below. The taxpayer will be required to generate the challan from the portal and submit the same in any of the listed banks with cash / draft for payment of Professional Tax.



- 10. After selecting the preferred mode for payment of professional Tax, the system will forward to the selected bank portal / payment gateway portal for authentication and processing of payment. At the selected bank portal / payment gateway portal, the taxpayer will provide their user ID and Password to process the payment from their selected bank / Debit Card / UPI or Wallet (as the case may be) in the standard process.
- 11. Once the payment is successful, a receipt will be generated from the Treasury portal for the taxpayer. Please note that the Treasury Challan will be generated after 24 hours as per the standard process of confirmation of payment through e-Kuber platform of Reserve Bank of India
- 12. There is no need to submit the physical copy of the challan to the Tax Officer. The payment details will be updated in the official portal of CT & GST organisation in next 48-72 hours.
